For CSR the evening of November 3, 2007 was a fascinating rendezvous with the future of India—the youth fired with a mission to change the course of events for the better. Mr. Raja Banthia won the Super Brain Youth Award comprising CSR Gold Medal, CSR Super Brain Youth Trophy and Delhi-London-Delhi Air Ticket besides other prizes. Lt. Swarnendu Roy and Ms. Sapna H. Gaherwal, the 1st and the 2nd Runners-up won the CSR Super Brain Trophies along with various other prizes.

Enthused by the ever-increasing tremendous response from the intellectual world, we plan, as hitherto, to conduct the Super Brain Youth Contest 2008 (open to all citizens of India in the age group of 21 - 28 as on October 1, 2007) in *two stages*.



# CSR Gold Awards 2008

As a part of **Stage I**, there will be a Super Brain Essay Contest every month. Two new topics for the Essay Contest will be announced. The candidates will write an essay either in English or Hindi on any one of the announced topics.

As suggested by most of you, there will be four First Prize Winners every month. In other words, two essays each in English and Hindi on two different topics will be chosen for the four First Prizes. In each contest will, thus, emerge four Intellectuals. All the four first prize winning essays will be published in *CSR English/CSR Hindi*. The duration of the Contest will be six months.

At the conclusion of the 6-month Essay Contest, all the 24 prize winners, including 12 with English and 12 with Hindi as their respective medium of writing, will be sent a General Knowledge Paper (Descriptive Type) and Personality Test as the second part of the Stage I of the Contest. On the basis of the evaluation of the answers of the General Knowledge Paper, there would be a final selection of eight contestants out of the 24.

As a part of the **Stage II** of the Contest, all the eight finalists will be invited to participate in the **CSR Super Brain Youth Contest 2008**, to be held in New Delhi, for which the time and venue will be announced later. The second stage of the Contest will comprise Personality Test including Interviews, Group Discussions and other Tests of the selected candidates.

On the basis of the performance of the Stage II of the Contest, the panel of judges will select **CSR Super Brain 2008**. Two **Runners-up (I and II)** will also be selected.

The winner of Super Brain Youth Award will get many other prizes in addition to a **Return Ticket to LONDON, CSR Super Brain Trophy and a CSR Gold Medal**. The **1st Runner-up and the 2nd Runner-up** will get **CSR Super Brain Youth Trophies, besides other prizes**. There will also be a lot of other prizes and surprises for the winners.
